Overview:

The Salvation Army Brooklyn Brownsville Corps "Helping Hand" Grant is awarded to students graduating from high school in the Brownsville/East New York community. The Salvation Army, an international movement, is an evangelical part of the universal Christian Church. Its message is based on the Bible. Its ministry is motivated by the love of God. Its mission is to preach the gospel of Jesus Christ and to meet human needs in His name without discrimination. We are the Greater New York Division of The Salvation Army, and for over 130 years, we've dedicated ourselves to doing the most good for the men, women and children in our area who need it most.

Use of the Grant:

The "Helping Hand" Grant shall be a one-time grant award presented upon proof of enrollment to a college, university, community college, technical or trade school. *For 2025, the grant amount will be up to \$500.00.* The award recipient(s) must attend an accredited college, university, community college, technical or trade school. The applicant must be accepted at any of these institutions at the time of the award presentation. Proof of acceptance, (i.e.; Bursar's registration bill, school housing receipt, or other official documents) will be required to receive the grant award.

Award Guidelines and Eligibility:

The "Helping Hand" Grant award is based upon personal achievements, character, social awareness, volunteer efforts, and career goals as communicated by the applicant and supporting recommendations. Each applicant must provide a completed application, and supporting recommendations by the stated application deadline.

The graduating senior must attend one of the following high schools:

- > W. H. Maxwell Career and Technical Education High School
- Fredrick Douglas Academy VIII High School
- Brownsville Academy High School
- Teacher's Preparatory High School

Thomas Jefferson Educational Campus:

- > Performing Arts and Technology High School
- > World Academy for Total Community Health High School
- FDNY High School for Fire and Life Safety
- High School for Civil Rights

Minimum grade point average to apply for the "Helping Hand" Grant is 2.3 on a 4.0 scale.

Selection Process:

The selection committee will evaluate all qualified applicants. The decision will be based on information obtained from the applications submitted and discussions with the applicant. The decision of the selection committee will be final.

The two recommendations can be from a teacher, instructor, coach, community leader, religious leader, or supervisor who worked with the applicant, or any other adult (not a family member) who is familiar with applicant's personal achievements and abilities.


